SUBJECT: Department of Defense (DoD) Child Development System Fee Ranges for School Year 2011 - 2012

The Department of Defense (DoD) Child Development Program has approved the School Year 2011-2012 fee range as part of the 2010 Fee Range Policy. The suspense for completing the annual total income review is August 31, 2011.

In 2010, Office for the Secretary of Defense (OSD) approved DLA's request to implement the new fee structure incrementally over 2 years with full implementation of the target fees by School Year 2012 - 2013. This policy included a five percent increase in income ranges as well as the addition of three new categories. The 2011 - 2012 school year marks another increase for some categories prior to the leveling out of fees for the 2012 - 2013 school year. Not all categories will be affected this year. This two year Installation plan specific to Battle Creek is posted on the Stars and Stripes website at:

In addition, the Child and Youth Program Specialist will be sending a letter to all families informing them of the fee changes, how the income is determined, and what documents are required for income determination. The income determination will begin 30 days after the date of the letter.


Below is the DoD Childcare Development Center fee range for School Year 2011 - 2012:

Category	Total Family Income	Weekly Fee per Child
I	\$0 - \$29,400	\$50.00
II	\$29,401 - \$35,700	\$65.00
III	\$35,701 - \$46,200	\$80.00
IV	\$46,201 - \$57,750	\$96.00
V	\$57,751 - \$73,500	\$111.00
VI	\$73,501 - \$85,000	\$125.00
VII	\$85,001 - \$100,000	\$129.00
VIII	\$100,001 - \$125,000	\$131.00
IX	\$125,000 +	\$133.00

Changes in the 2011-2012 Fee Range Policy are as follows:

- Categories III, IV, V and VII will see a 2% increase in fees, resulting in a \$2 weekly change.
- Category VIII will also see a 2% increase in fees, resulting in a \$3 weekly change.
- Category IX will see a 3% increase, resulting in a \$4 weekly change.
